



Spiral Snakes

Materials Needed:

- Paper plate
- Pencil
- Scissors
- Glue
- Colored tissue paper OR colored paper
- Red paper
- Googly eyes (optional)
- Hole puncher
- String

Activity Instructions:

1. Cut the colored tissue paper or colored paper into small squares
2. Flip the paper plate upside down
3. Glue the colored squares all over the paper plate as desired
4. Allow to dry
5. Cut off any tissue paper sticking out along the edges of your paper plate
6. Using a pencil, draw a spiral about 3 times towards the center of the plate, starting with the snake's head at the edge of the plate and ending with the snake's tail at the center of the plate
7. Either make snake eyes out of colored paper, draw on eyes, or glue 2 googly eyes onto the snake's head
8. Cut out a red tongue and glue underneath the snake's head
9. Using a hole puncher, carefully punch a hole in the middle of the snake's tail
10. Thread a string through the hole and tie a knot to secure
11. Enjoy your snake!
