



Flying Rocket Ship

Materials Needed:

- Toilet paper roll
- Paint
- Small paper plate or paint cup
- Paintbrush
- Colored paper
- Colored tissue paper
- Scissors
- Glue
- Tape
- Pencil
- Straw

Activity Instructions:

1. Pour a small amount of paint into a small bowl or plate
2. Paint your toilet paper roll and let dry
3. Draw a medium circle on the colored paper and cut out
4. Cut a line from one end of the circle to the center
5. Make a cone from your circle to form the rocket nose
6. Tape where the cut ends come together
7. Attach the rocket nose by taping under the cone to the top of the toilet paper roll
8. Cut out small circles from the colored paper to make rocket ship windows
9. Glue onto the toilet paper roll
10. Cut strips of yellow, orange, or red tissue paper to make flames
11. Glue the tissue paper strips on the inside of the bottom of your rocket
12. Carefully using a pencil, poke a hole on one side of your rocket *Parents, please help your child with this for safety
13. Using liquid glue or a glue gun, glue one end of a straw into the hole *Parents, please help your child with using a glue gun for safety

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
