

Jingle Bells Sing Along

Sing along to "Jingle Bells" with your child using these different activities.

Learning Opportunities

- Encourage your child to use simple signs while singing along to the song:
 - I want (e.g., "Do you want to sing Jingle Bells? Can you say "I want"?)
 - More (e.g., pause the song midway through and ask "Do you want more songs?")
 - All done (e.g., if your child does not want to sing anymore, ask "Are you all done singing songs?")
- Use a laundry basket/box as a pretend sleigh
 - Rock your child back and forth in the basket
 - Place a pillow below the basket while rocking your child to encourage him/her to work on balance
- Use bells (or any other instrument) to shake along to the song in different ways and encourage your child to practice following directions
 - Slow vs. Fast shakes
 - Soft vs. Loud shakes
 - Go vs. Stop shaking

Materials

- Device to play the YouTube song video on
- Laundry basket or box
- Bells (or any other instrument)

Areas of Development

- Speech and language skills
- Postural control/balance
- Cognition
