

Shamrock Shape Puzzle

Materials:

- Printables
- Scissors* (for parental use)
- Glue

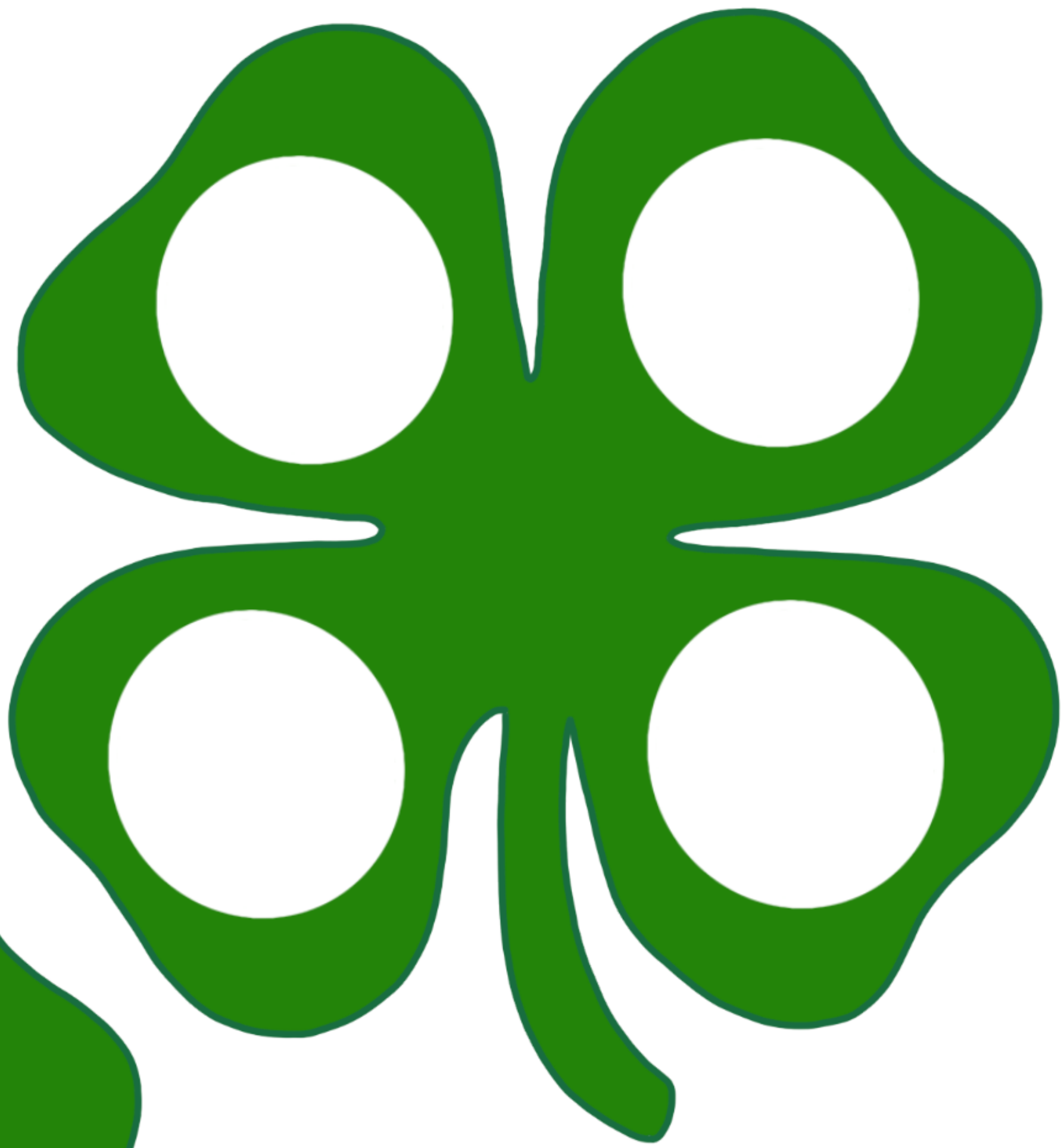
*Warning: Please do not leave your child unattended with any of the materials at any time.

Benefits:

- Shape recognition
- Problem solving
- Cognition and concentration

Instructions:

1. Print out the printables (on pages 2-3)
2. Cut out the shapes on page 3
3. Match the shapes to the shamrock with the corresponding shape
4. Demonstrate and narrate for your child
 - a. "The square goes on square"
 - b. Count how many shapes you have and how many you have left once you put one on
 - c. Name the different colors of each shape
 - d. Give your child options to choose between.
(e.g., "Do you want the square or the circle?" or "which hand has the circle?")
5. Once your child is able to match the shapes, have them glue the pieces on. Provide hand over hand assistance if needed.
